



Federation of Scottish Aquarist Societies Guidelines for Auctions

- 1.** Two copies of detailed list of contents and owner to be handed in with lot, one copy to be retained in box, the other for public display prior to auction.
- 2.** All bags must be clearly marked with details of contents. If bags are not marked, they should be returned to owner for marking or withdrawal from auction.
- 3.** Any fish deemed by auctioneer/helpers not to be in good condition will not be sold and returned to owner
- 4.** If there are more than one bag of a species in a lot, the successful bidder to be given the opportunity of buying all or any of the remainder of the bags of that species at the same price.
- 5.** The starting price for any bags with a reserve price should be the reserve price. If a lot does not achieve the reserve price, the lot shall be returned to the owner, but with no commission, based on the reserve price, being paid by the owner. Reserve prices should not be lowered.
- 6.** Rate of commission to be decided by host authority.
